ENGLISH EXAMINATION –IB 1 ENGLISH A LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE SL/HL CANDIDATES- SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS:

1 Literary texts analysis and interpretation

The candidate will be required to read a literary extract and answer questions testing their skills of textual analysis and interpretation. The candidate will be expected to demonstrate

- -understanding of theme, purpose, mood, tone and message
- -knowledge of major stylistic devices such as metaphor, simile, repetition, hyperbole, personification
- -ability to discuss effect(s) of text features on the reader

2 Non-literary text analysis and interpretation

The candidate will be required to read a non-literary extract and write a textual analysis in response to a guiding question. The candidate will be expected to demonstrate:

- -ability to recognise literal and figurative meanings of the text and interpret some implications of the text
- -ability to offer references to the text that are relevant and support the candidate's ideas
- -generally appropriate analysis of textual features/authorial choices
- -ability to present ideas in a generally coherent and cohesive manner
- -adequate focus on the guiding question in the analysis
- -ability to use clear and carefully chosen language with an adequate degree of accuracy in grammar, vocabulary and sentence construction
- -ability to use formal register and style in writing
